Cats

If you're looking to board your cat, our rates are \$25 per day/night. However, if you're boarding a dog at the same time, the rate drops to \$20.

To ensure the health and safety of all our feline guests, we require that all cats and kittens are vaccinated for feline infectious enteritis (panleukopenia), rhinotracheitis (herpes) and calicivirus. Please bring your cat's vaccination book with you when checking in.

Vaccinations

We prioritise the health and safety of all our guests. Therefore, we require all dogs to be fully vaccinated for Parvovirus and Kennel Cough, with vaccinations administered at least 2 weeks prior to their stay. Please bring your pet's vaccination book with you upon check-in, as it is a mandatory requirement for boarding.

Medication

We do not charge extra for pets on medication. However, we kindly ask that you inform us of any medication requirements during the booking process. To ensure the safety of your pet, all medication must be clearly labeled with your pet's name and dosage instructions.

Worming and Fleaing

Keeping our furry guests happy and healthy is our top priority at Cosy Paws. That's why we require all dogs to be wormed and flea treated one week prior to their stay. Please ensure your furry friend is up-to-date with their treatments, as any dogs found not to be will be treated and owners will be charged for the product.

Excercise

We understand that exercise is essential for keeping your furry friend happy and healthy. That's why we tailor our exercise routines to suit your dog's unique needs and energy level.
